10x10 vinyl with doors in a permanent barn, or box stalls of wooden construction in a permanent barn.

Stabling will be available at \$125.00 for the weekend, bedding included. Stall fees postmarked and/or received after Oct. 12 will be \$150.00

RULES & REGULATIONS

HARD HATS WITH PROPERLY FITTED AND SECURELY FASTENED HARNESS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES BY EVERYONE WHEN MOUNTED.

- In some classes, the area of the courtesy circle is restricted. This
 will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring.
- Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes should lack of entries warrant and to refuse any entry.
- All Hunter Classes will be judged on performance and soundness.
- A rotating jumping order will be established and posted for all classes over fences.
- No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order.

Schooling may be available each evening after course adjustment.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Eight ribbons will be awarded in each Hunter class.

A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be given in each Hunter section that includes an Under Saddle class.

<u>Note:</u> Ponies shown by a junior in any pony division (Pony Hunter, Green Pony Hunter, Children's Pony Hunter) **cannot be shown by an adult** at the same competition, except in breeding classes in-hand.

VERY GREEN HUNTER - Classes 2, 3, 4

Open to horses and ponies. Fences 2'6". Horses and ponies may not cross enter into any class with fences higher than 3'at the same show, and may only receive points in this section for one year.

LOW HUNTER - Classes 5, 6, 10

Open to all horses and ponies. Fences 3'.

PRE-GREEN HUNTER 3' or 3'3" - Classes 7, 8, 9

A Pre-Green Hunter is a horse of any age in its first or second year of showing over 3' – 3'3" fences. Fences not to exceed 3'3".

PERFORMANCE/HIGH-PERFORMANCE HUNTER – Classes 112, 113, 114 Open to all horses. Fences to be 3'3", 3'6", AND 4'.

GREEN HUNTER- Classes 12, 13, 14

A Green Hunter is a horse of any age that is in his first or second year of showing in any classes at 3'6" or higher. Fences to be 3'6" for 1st year horses and 3'9" for 2nd year horses.

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER - Classes 83, 84, 85

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders may not cross enter into any other OPHA recognized section. No oxer and no In and Out. Fences 2'.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY HUNTER - Classes 87, 90, 91

Open to ponies ridden by a Junior exhibitor. Riders competing in the Children's Hunter Pony section are not limited to the number of ponies they may show, providing they are not also competing in the Green or Regular Hunter Pony sections and/or Children's Hunter Horse section at the same competition, except in competitions with their own entry restrictions. Children's Hunter Pony riders are limited to competing a maximum of one (1) different pony in the Green or Regular Pony Hunter section and one (1) horse in the Children's Hunter horse section at the same competition and in any class not to exceed 3'5". Fences 2' for small and medium and 2'6" for large ponies; spreads not to exceed fence height.

LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTER - Classes 63, 64, 65

To be ridden by a junior exhibitor. Fences 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into any class on the same horse in which fences exceed 2'6" or in any class where fences exceed 3'3".

CHILDREN'S HUNTER 3' - Classes 67, 70, 71

To be ridden by a Junior exhibitor. Riders may not cross enter into any class in which fences exceed 3'5" at the same show, (Exception: Equitation classes up to 3'9", Jumper classes 1.20m and lower, Junior Hunter sections and USHJA International Hunter Derby). Fences 3, spreads not to exceed fence height. Rider restrictions: A Children's Hunter Horse rider may only compete one different horse in the Junior Hunter Sections. A Junior Hunter rider may only compete one different horse in the Children's Hunter Horse section. Riders entered in the Children's Hunter Horse section may only compete on one Children's Hunter Pony at the same competition.

PONY HUNTER - Classes 77, 78, 80

Classes limited to ponies 14.2 hands and under, and show by riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Judged on performance and soundness. Manners and suitability of pony and rider emphasized. Extreme speed penalized. Small ponies 2'3", Medium ponies 2'6", Large ponies 3'.

GREEN PONY HUNTER - Classes 75, 76, 79

A Green Pony Hunter is a pony not exceeding 14.2 hands, of any age, in its first year of showing in any classes that require ponies to jump the regulation height or higher in their respective sections (2'3" small, 2'6" medium, 2'9" large).

JUNIOR HUNTER 3'3" or 3'6" - Classes 45, 46, 49

Open to Juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Performance, soundness, and manners to count. Extreme speed penalized.

AMATEUR OWNER 3'3" or 3'6" - Classes 47, 48, 51

To be ridden by Amateur Owners or an Amateur Member of the owner's family. To be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners.

LOW ADULT HUNTER - Classes 53, 54, 55

Open to Amateurs Riders. Cross entry between the Low Adult section and the Amateur Owner section is prohibited. Fences 2'6". Same horse/rider combination may nominate for only one of the following: Low Adult Hunter, Adult/Amateur Hunter and Amateur/Owner Hunter.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER 2'9-3' - Classes 57, 59, 60

Horses to be ridden by amateurs. Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same competition where fences exceed 3'5" (Equitation, Jumper classes 1.20m and lower, Amateur Owner Hunter, Amateur Owner Jumper classes, and the USHJA International Hunter Derby). Any rider showing in the Amateur Owner Hunter division may compete with 1 different horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter division and must own or have a USEF lease of said horse. Fences 3', spreads not to exceed fence heights. Ponies may be shown by Adults, suitability to count. An unrestricted Children's/Adult Hunter division may be offered open to all Amateurs and Juniors, with fences not to exceed 3'3". Same horse/rider combination may nominate for only one of the following: Low Adult Hunter, Adult Amateur Hunter, Amateur Owner Hunter.

SCHOOLING SHOW CLASSES WALK / TROT - Classes 103, 104, 105, 106

Open to riders of any age on horses or ponies. Crossrails 1'6".

WALK / TROT / CANTER - Classes 107, 108, 110, 111

Open to riders of any age on horses or ponies. Crossrails 1'6".

LIMIT RIDER - Classes 93, 94, 95, 96

Open to riders of any age. Fences 2'. Oxers not permitted.

NOVICE RIDER - Classes 97, 98, 100, 101

Open to riders of any age on horses or ponies. Fences 2'3" to 2'6".

JUMPER DIVISIONS

Eight ribbons will be awarded in each Jumper class.

A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded in the Low Children's/ Adult Jumper, Children's /Adult Jumper, and Intermediate Children's/Adult Jumper Divisions

TRAINING JUMPER BLUE RIBBON Fences 3' - Min. Speed 360 yds/min. Class 15

LOW SCHOOLING JUMPER BLUE RIBBON Fences 3'6" Min. spd 360 yds/min. Class 16

HIGH SCHOOLING JUMPER BLUE RIBBON Fences 3'9" - 4' Min. speed 360 yds/min. Class 17

JUNIOR/AMATEUR JUMPER Horses in this section must be ridden by an Amateur Owner or Amateur member of the owner's family or by a Junior exhibitor. Fences 3'9"-4' Min. speed 360 yds/min. Classes 18, 19

CHILDREN'S/ADULT JUMPER Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by a Junior competitor, and exhibitors who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior exhibitors. All adults must be Amateurs. Riders may cross enter into the Junior/Amateur Jumper section on a different horse. The horse/rider combination may not compete in any other class where fences exceed 4'3". Fences 3'6" - Min. speed 360 yds/min. Classes 20, 21, 22

LOW CHILDREN'S/ADULT AMATEUR JUMPER Open to junior/ amateur riders. Fence heights to be set at 1.00 m (3'3"). Riders may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15 m (3'9") at the same competition. Horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers. Classes 23, 24, 25

INTERMEDIATE CHILDREN'S/ADULT JUMPER Open to junior/amateur riders. Fence height 2'9" - 3'. The horse/rider combination may not cross enter into any class at the same show with fences higher that 3'3". Horse/rider combination must stay the same within a competition. Classes 26, 27, 28

HUNTER SEAT EQUITATION

All classes to be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of mount. Eight ribbons each class.

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 each, except where otherwise noted.

FLAT EQUITATION 17 AND UNDER Riders to walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Test 1-19 optional. Class 50

LOW ADULT EQUTATION/FLAT Riders to walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Class 115

ADULT EQUITATION/FLAT Riders to walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring, Class 56

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION/FLAT Short Stirrup riders 11 yrs. & under. Class 86

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY EQUITATION/FLAT To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Class 88

LOW CHILDREN'S EQUITATION/FLAT To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Class 66

CHILDREN'S EQUITATION/FLAT Riders eligible for the Children's divisions. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Class 68

PONY EQUITATION/FLAT To be shown at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring. Test 1-7 optional. **Class 81**

GASCOIGNE PONY MEDAL Open to riders eligible for the Pony Hunter Division. To be shown over a course of not less than 6 obstacles at 2'3" sm, 2'6" med, 2'9"- 3' lg. See OPHA rule book for complete class specifications. **ENTRY FEE: \$25.00. Class 73**

FOX SMITH MEDAL Open to riders eligible for the Children's Hunter Division. To be shown over a course of not less than 8 fences at 3', with two changes of direction. See OPHA rule book for complete class specifications. **ENTRY FEE: \$25.00. Class 72**

OPHA HUNTER SEAT MEDAL CLASS Open to Junior riders. See OPHA rule book for complete class specifications. Fences 3'6". **ENTRY FEE: \$25.00. Class 44**

NARHA MEDAL Adult Equitation Class. Open to all Amateur riders except Amateur owners. Fences 3'. See OPHA rule book for complete class specifications. **ENTRY FEE:** \$25.00. Class 61

HUNTER BREEDING

Open to thoroughbred and non-thoroughbred horses. All breeding classes shall be judged on conformation, way of moving, quality, substance, soundness and suitability to become a Hunter. Horses are to be judged for conformation before being walked or trotted. **Classes 35, 36, 37, 38**

PONY HUNTER BREEDING

Open to ponies not to exceed 14.2 hands. All breeding classes shall be judged on conformation, way of moving, quality, substance, soundness and suitability to become a pony hunter. Ponies are to be judged for conformation before being walked or trotted. Classes 39, 40, 41, 42

GRAND CHAMPION HUNTER AWARD

This award will be presented to the Horse or Pony/rider combination that earns the most points in hunter /pony classes over fences and under saddle. Schooling classes 1/2 points.

GRAND CHAMPION JUMPER AWARD

This award will be presented to the horse that accumulates the most points in Jumper classes.


