

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Eight ribbons will be awarded in each Hunter class.

A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be given in each Hunter section that includes an Under Saddle class.

VERY GREEN HUNTER - Classes 2, 3, 4

Open to horses and ponies. Fences 2'6"Horses and ponies may not cross enter into any class with fences higher than 2'6" at the same show, and may only receive points in this section for one year.

LOW HUNTER - Classes 5, 6, 10

Open to all horses and ponies. Fences 3'.

PRE-GREEN HUNTER 3' or 3'3" - Classes 7, 8, 9

A Pre-Green Hunter is a horse of any age in its first or second year of showing over 3' – 3'3" fences. Fences not to exceed 3'3".

GREEN/HIGH PERFORMANCE HUNTER 3'6", 3'9" and 4' – Classes 12, 13, 14
A Green Hunter is a horse of any age that is in his first or second year of showing in any

classes. Fences to be 3'6" for 1st year horses, 3'9" for 2nd year horses and 4' for high performance horses. To be judged on performance and soundness.

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER - Classes 83, 84, 85

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders may not cross enter into any other OPHA recognized section. No oxer and no In and Out. Fences 2'.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY - Classes 87, 90, 91

Open to ponies ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. Riders may not cross enter into any classes in which fences exceed 3'3" at the same show. Fences 2' for small and medium, 2'6" for large ponies; spreads not to exceed height of fence.

LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTER - Classes 63, 64, 65

To be ridden by a Junior exhibitor. Riders may not cross enter into any class in which fences are higher than 2'6". Fences 2'6". Entries need not be jogged for soundness.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER 3' - Classes 67, 70, 71

To be ridded by a Junior exhibitor. Neither horses or riders may cross enter into the Junior Hunter section at the same show. Spreads not to exceed fence heights. Entries need not be jogged for soundness.

PONY HUNTER - Classes 77, 78, 80

Classes limited to ponies 14.2 hands and under, and show by riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Judged on performance and soundness. Manners and suitability of pony and rider emphasized. Extreme speed penalized. Small ponies 2'3", Medium ponies 2'6", Large ponies 3'.

GREEN PONY HUNTER - Classes 75, 76, 79

A green pony is a pony of any age not exceeding 14.2 hands that has not been shown over fences at the regulation height or higher for its respective section. Fences: Small ponies 2'3", Medium ponies 2'6", Large ponies 2'9".

JUNIOR HUNTER 3'3" or 3'6" - Classes 45, 46, 49

Open to Juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Measurement cards required. Performance, soundness and manners to count. Extreme speed penalized.

AMATEUR OWNER 3'3" or 3'6" - Classes 47, 48, 51

To be ridden by Amateur Owners or an Amateur Member of the owner's family. To be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners.

LOW ADULT HUNTER - Classes 53, 54, 55

Open to Amateurs Riders. Cross entry between the Low Adult section and the Amateur Owner section is prohibited. Fences 2'6". Same horse/rider combination may nominate for only one of the following: Low Adult Hunter, Adult/Amateur Hunter and Amateur/Owner Hunter.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER 2'9-3' - Classes 57, 59, 60

To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same competition where fences exceed 3'3", except the Adult Amateur Jumper and Amateur Owner Hunter. Any rider showing in the Amateur Owner Hunter Division may compete one horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter division. Fences 2'9" - 3'; spreads not to exceed fence height. Ponies may be ridden by adults, suitability to count. Entries need not to be jogged for soundness.

SCHOOLING SHOW CLASSES

WALK / TROT - Classes 103, 104, 105, 106

Open to riders of any age on horses or ponies. Crossrails 1'6".

WALK / TROT / CANTER - Classes 107, 108, 110, 111

Open to riders of any age on horses or ponies. Crossrails 1'6".

LIMIT RIDER - Classes 93, 94, 95, 96


Open to riders of any age. Fences 2'. Oxers not permitted.

NOVICE RIDER - Classes 97, 98, 100, 101

Open to riders of any age on horses or ponies. Fences 2'3" to 2'6".

JUMPER DIVISIONS

Eight ribbons will be awarded in each Jumper class.

A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded in the Low Children's/Adult Jumper, Children's/Adult Jumper and Intermediate Children's/Adult Jumper Divisions

TRAINING JUMPER - Fences 3' - Min. Speed 360 yds/min. - Class 15

LOW SCHOOLING BL. RIBBON JUMPER - Fences 3'6" Min. spd 360 yds/min. Class-16

HIGH SCHOOLING BLUE RIBBON JUMPER - Fences 3'9" - 4' Min. speed 360 yds/min. **Class 17**

JUNIOR/AMATEUR JUMPER - Horses in this section must be ridden by an Amateur Owner or Amateur member of the owner's family or by a Junior exhibitor. Fences 3'9"-4' Min. speed 360 yds/min. **Classes – 18, 19**

CHILDREN'S/ADULT JUMPER - Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by a Junior competitor, and exhibitors who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior exhibitors. All adults must be Amateurs. The horse/rider combination may not compete in any other class at the same show where fences exceed 3'9". Fences 3'6" - Min. speed 360 yds/min. **Classes – 20, 21, 22**

LOW CHILDREN'S/ADULT AMATEUR JUMPER - Riders may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m (3'9") at the same competition. Horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers at the same show. Fence heights to be set at 1.00m (3'3"). **Classes 23, 24, 25**

INTERMEDIATE CHILDREN'S/ADULT JUMPER

Open to junior/amateur riders. The horse/rider combination may not cross enter into any class at the same show with fences higher than 3'3". Fences 3' Classes 26, 27, 28

HUNTER SEAT EQUITATION

All classes to be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of mount. Eight ribbons each class. **ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 each**, except where otherwise noted.

FLAT EQUITATION 17 AND UNDER - Riders to walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Test 1-19 optional. – **Class 50**

ADULT EQUITATION/FLAT - Riders to walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. - Class 56

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION/FLAT - Short Stirrup riders 11 yrs. & under - Class 86

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY EQUITATION/FLAT - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring - Class 88

Open to riders eligible for the Pony Hunter Division. To be shown over a course of not less than 6 obstacles at 2'3" sm, 2'6" med, 2'9"- 3' lg. See OPHA rule book for complete class specifications. – **Class 73**

FOX SMITH MEDAL - Open to riders eligible for the Children's Hunter Division. To be shown over a course of not less than 8 fences at 3', with two changes of direction.

- Class 72 ENTRY FEE: \$25.00 See OPHA rule book for complete class specifications.

OPHA HUNTER SEAT MEDAL CLASSENTRY FEE: \$25.00 Open to Junior riders. Fences 3'6". – Class 44

NARHA MEDAL.....ENTRY FEE: \$25.00

Adult Equitation Class. Open to all Amateur riders except Amateur owners. Fences 3'. – Class 61

HUNTER BREEDING

Open to thoroughbred and non-thoroughbred horses. All breeding classes shall be judged on conformation, way of moving, quality, substance, soundness and suitability to become a Hunter. Horses are to be judged for conformation before being walked or trotted. — **Classes 35, 36, 37, 38**

PONY HUNTER BREEDING

Open to ponies not to exceed 14.2 hands. All breeding classes shall be judged on conformation, way of moving, quality, substance, soundness and suitability to become a pony hunter. Ponies are to be judged for conformation before being walked or trotted. **Classes 39, 40, 41, 42**

GRAND CHAMPION HUNTER AWARD

This award will be presented to the Horse or Pony/rider combination that earns the most points in hunter /pony classes over fences and under saddle. Schooling classes 1/2 points.

GRAND CHAMPION JUMPER AWARD

This award will be presented to the horse that accumulates the most points in Jumper classes.
