MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

ENTRIES: Closing Date - Thursday • April 19, 2012

Online entry available - www.horseshowing.com (Checks should be made payable to OPHA and sent to: PO Box 23421, Chagrin Falls, OH 44023). There will be a \$30.00 one-time post entry fee after closing date. Horses shown in classes in which they have not entered will be required to pay a DOUBLE ENTRY FEE for those classes.

Entry blanks will be accepted ONLY when signed by the owner, trainer, coaches and riders and accompanied by a check for STABLING FEES. Be sure to include the USEF Membership Number of the trainer, coaches, OWNER and riders on the entry form, as well as Horse/Pony ID #s.

CREDENTIALS:

All exhibitors in the Pony and Junior Hunter sections must present their measurement cards at the office. All Pony or Junior Hunters who do not possess a current measurement card will be measured. **Measurement will take place Friday p.m. and Saturday a.m. Exact times will be announced.** Please include copies of measurement cards with entries. All exhibitors in Amateur sections must present their Amateur certification at the office. Numbers will not be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order. All participants (rider, driver, handler, owner, trainer, agent or lessee) as provided in Article GR1309, must present to the competition secretary a current membership card or copy thereof.

STABLING:

10x10 vinyl with doors in a permanent barn, or box stalls of wooden construction in a permanent barn. Cost of the stall will be **\$125.00**. Bedding included. NO STALL WILL BE RESERVED UNLESS STALL FEES ARE PAID BY THE CLOSING OF ENTRIES - THURSDAY, APRIL 19, 2012. STALL FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE:

The OPHA, their officials, employees and Chagrin Valley Farms will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant, or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. **THIS WILL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOW AND SHOW GROUNDS.**

- All mounted exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets when riding anywhere on competition grounds.
- Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes should lack of entries warrant and to refuse any entry.
- Location of phone for emergency use will be located in the horse show trailer.
- In some classes, the area of the courtesy circle may be restricted. If so, this will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring.
- A rotating jumping order may be established and posted for all classes over fences.
- Prize money exceeding balance due will be paid by check and mailed within 30 days of the show's completion.
- A \$15.00 Grounds Fee will be charged to all entries.
- A processing fee of \$20.00 plus collection fees will be made for any non-negotiable checks.
- No alterations are to be made to permanent stabling or other facilities by exhibitors.
- Non-showing horses stabled at the show will be charged a \$65.00 non-showing fee plus the \$15 grounds fee.
- No smoking is permitted in any buildings.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. **The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation.** Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USHJA Registration Numbers

All horses entered must have USHJA Registration Numbers. See HU 101.1 and JP 100.2 of USEF rule book.

HUNTERS:

All Hunter Classes will be judged on performance and soundness. One class in rated Hunters will be a Handy Hunter class. A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be given in each Hunter section that includes any under saddle class. Hunter Ring - 250'x300' limestone mixture footing. Hunter warmup area - limestone mixture footing.

JUMPERS:

A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded to the two horses which have acquired the most points in each jumper section. Horses tied for other than first place, the tie shall be broken by the time taken in the first round. Jumper Ring - 225'x300' sand/limestone mixture

SCHOOLING:

The rings may be open for schooling on the flat each morning, and following the close of the show day - WEATHER PERMITTING.

REFUNDS:

No Stall Fees or Nominating Fees Will Be Refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes which they have entered forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class or classes entered. Proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office before the start of the class or classes that are being scratched. This must be accompanied by a certificate from the official show veterinarian. In either case above the entry fees will be refunded less an office processing charge of \$20.00.

In accordance with GR 1111.4: Canada, IA, WI, MO, TN, VA, WV, PA, NJ are contiguous states.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER:

To be ridden by amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as junior exhibitors. Riders entered in Adult Amateur Hunter sections may not compete in any other class in which obstacles exceed 3'5" at the same competition, except equitation, jumper classes 1.20m and lower, and Amateur Owner Hunter and Amateur Owner Jumper classes. Riders competing in the Amateur Owner Hunter or Amateur Owner Jumper sections may compete on one different owned horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter section. Horses cannot cross enter into 3'3" or 3'6" Amateur Owner sections at the same competition. Ponies may be ridden by adults. If an under saddle class is divided by age and a rider has two or more horses entered, all riders must be amateurs but need not be eligible by age. When a section is divided by age of rider no horse may compete in more than one section. When sections are split by age they must be split as 18-35 years, 36-49 years and 50 years and over. Horses and ponies may be jogged at the competition management's discretion. Handy Hunter Classes are optional and can be added at the competition management's discretion. Fence Heights to be set at 3'. The Adult Amateur section may be combined with Children's Hunter Horse if there are four or less in either section.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE: Open to Junior Exhibitors. *Riders entered in the 3' Children's Hunter Horse section may not compete in any other class in which obstacles exceed 3'5" at the same competition except 3'6" Equitation, Jumper classes 1.20m and lower and Junior Hunter sections. Riders entered in the 3' or 3'3" Children's Hunter Horse sections may not cross enter classes exceeding 4' or jumper classes 1.20m or higher. A Children's Hunter Horse rider may only compete one different horse in the Junior Hunter Sections. A Junior Hunter rider may only compete one different horse in either the Children's 3' or 3'3" Hunter Horse sections. Horses entered in Children's Hunter classes may not cross enter into Junior Hunter sections at the same competition. When sections are offered by age they must be offered as 14 Years and under, and 15- 17Years Old. Handy Classes are optional and can be added at the Competition Management's discretion. Horses may be jogged at the Competition Management's discretion. Fence heights 3' or 3'3". Sections can be combined if entries warrant.*

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY:

Open to Junior Exhibitors. Pony may not cross into any rated section at the same competition. Classes may be run as one or split Small/Medium and Large to run at 2', 2'6" respectively. Children's Hunter Pony Riders may compete on a maximum of one horse in the Children's Hunter horse section at the same competition and in any class not to exceed 3'5" - exception Pony Jumpers. Ponies may be jogged at the horse show management's discretion. Green and Regular Hunter Pony Riders may compete on a maximum of one additional pony in the Children's Pony Hunter section at the same competition.

When sections are combined, suggested distances for the Children's Hunter Pony sections follow:

- 2' Small Children's Hunter Pony should be (based on 9'9" stride): 4 strides at 48'9"; 5 strides at 58'6"; 6 strides at 68'3"; 7 strides at 78'8"; 8 strides at 87'9".
- 2'3" Medium Children's Hunter Pony should be (based on a 10'3" stride): 4 strides at 51'3"; 5 strides at 61'6"; 6 strides at 71'9"; 7 strides at 82'; 8 strides at 92'3".
- 2'6" Large Children's Hunter Pony should be (based on an 11' stride): 4 strides at 51'3"; 5 strides at 66'; 6 strides at 77'; 7 strides at 88'; 8 strides at 99'.

CHILDREN'S /ADULT AMATEUR JUMPER:

Fence Heights to be set at 1.10 -1.15m. Sections may be divided by age of rider and may also be combined (*Children's with Adult Amateur sections*) if so stated in the prize list. Adult Amateur/Children Jumper Rider may not cross enter into High Junior or Amateur/Owner classes or any other jumper class exceeding 1.25m at the same competition with the exception of classes which do not offer prize money (including add back money) see HU111 and HU108 for cross entry restrictions.

Low Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper: Sections may be divided by age of rider and may also be combined (*Children's with Adult Amateur sections*) if so stated in the prize list. *Riders in Low Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m (3'9") at the same competition. Horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers at the same show. Horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered. Fence heights to be set at 1.00m (3'3") to 1.05 m (3'5")* Zone awards will be given for High Children's/Adult Jumper classes as well as Low Children's and Adults classes. 2. Adult Amateur Jumper: To be ridden by exhibitors who are no longer eligible to compete as junior exhibitors. All exhibitors must be amateurs in accordance with General Rules, GR1306 and must show USEF amateur certification. 3. Children's Jumper: To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1 of the current competition year.

A Pre-Green Hunter is a horse of any age in his first or second year of showing over 3' or 3'3" fences. Fences not to exceed 3' or 3'3". A horse's Pre=Green Status is not affected by showing as a three-year-old. Classes may be divided by height section 3' and 3'3". You may not show in both height sections at the same competition. Horses may compete in both height sections within the same competition year. A horse's pre-green status may be reinstated for a future competition year if it was not shown at the 3' height or 3'3" height at more than four (4) competitions prior to September 1st and if it was not shown at that height after September 1st in the same year.




